Chroniton Manipulator

Barrowwight's Chroniton Manipulator allows him to travel through his own time stream - and be in two places at once! Jim is not set up in the prologue, instead roll 1D3. He can be placed anywhere on the table no closer than 6" to another model in the end phase of this turn. Once in play, Jim may activate the Manipulator by using a Special Action. This brings a future (or past!) version of himself into play. Place another Jim model within 2" of the original. The new Jim may be activated in this turn. The model has the same stats as above and each is counted as an entirely separate model for purposes of hits lost, Luck points etc.

However, the device is temperamental. In each End Phase when both Jims are in play, roll 1D6. On a roll of 5 remove the new Jim. On a roll of a 6 remove both models! If both models disappear, your opponent gains +2 VP.

Background

The first trial run of the Time Lift Project didn't quite go as planned. Spatial settings had been entered in feet instead of inches, resulting in the machinery grabbing an object far from the past and larger than intended. Royal Air Force officer and roguish charmer, Group Captain Jim Barrowwight was brought through to the present day from 1944, plucked from the war-torn skies of Britain. Darius and Professor Plantagenet created a wrist-mounted Chroniton Manipulator which stopped Barrowwight's time stream from dissipating and killing him. In subsequent episodes, he aided Project Time Lift in tackling such threats as the fearsome Chronosaur and the time-travelling policeman from The Ministry.

In times of great need, the Group Captain sometimes disappears, only to return several minutes later, with a bemused but willing double of himself ready to join the fray. By all accounts, he manages to pull his past self forward in time, often while he was in the bath, reading a book, or otherwise enjoying some quiet time. All of this time-bending is very confusing, even for scientists who make this kind of thing their day job.

The Group Captain's top secret military service file has been exhumed from the War Office's depths at Benton Troad's request. Troad refuses to allow anyone to see it, leaving the future of Jim Barrowwight to unfold as history sees fit.
